- The **Youth in Action 2024-2025** cohort culminated in April with **49 youth impacting 1800 and more** lives in the community.
- In the first quarter of 2025-2026, the Sambhav program focused on **mobilizing youth in various cities**. This quarter, our efforts specifically focused on two key verticals: Youth Adda and Youth in Action (YIA).
- The **team has expanded** with Shipra (Ahmedabad), bringing research expertise, and Sujata (Pune), with her experience in Coaching, will support and enhance Sambhav’s geographical and cultural reach.
